

WAYS TO SUPPORT:

1. School Programme:

- 1.1 Sponsor the cost of specific resource material used in education for sustainable development (e.g. interactive DVD, book or cards) - either per learner, group or school;
- 1.2 Sponsor the cost involved per workshop presented at a school (e.g. travelling cost of presenter/educator, material used, etc.);
- 1.3 Sponsor / assist in a specific sustainable development project managed by the WEF at a specific school (e.g. waste/water management programme, energy saving or “greening” project, etc.)

2. Corporate Presentations and/or workshops on Sustainable Development:

- 2.1 As a corporate organisation, promote and/or make use of a WEF professional as a guest speaker or presenter at one of your company’s events;
- 2.2 Making your company’s conference facility or other venue available to the WEF for the presentation of corporate presentations/workshops;
- 2.3 Sponsor the catering cost and/or speaker fee for a specific corporate presentation (e.g. for a special presentation on sustainable development to a specific corporate audience or launch of a new project);
- 2.4 Provide/sponsor the WEF with presentation equipment (e.g. sound equipment, etc.);
- 2.5 Assist/sponsor the WEF in organising a specific corporate with an interest in sustainable development to do a professional workshop/presentation at a specific venue (e.g. at a school);

3. Research & Development of Educational Resource Material:

- 3.1 Assist with, sponsor or make specific equipment available to the WEF in developing resource material (e.g. audiovisual equipment such as cameras or other recording apparatus used for the production of educational videos);
- 3.2 Provide sponsorship for specific resource material in exchange for adding your branding to the product (e.g. financial sponsorship for a new book on sustainable development, with your company logo then added to the cover of the book, etc.);
- 3.3 Provide skilled experts to assist in the development of specific products (e.g. IT expert to assist in development of specific software, or a project manager, graphic designer, etc.).
- 3.4 Support the WEF by purchasing specific products developed by the WEF (e.g. environmental diaries, coffee table books, etc.) as corporate gifts.
